Any blood tests and physical exams will need to be done by your local veterinarian if an in office consult is not done at our office. To successfully treat behavior problems, subtle physical problems must be checked for. We need the eyes and hands of your veterinarian examining your pet since I can't do that through the phone. Together we are a team to help your pet.
